

DUR-A-SOLVE

DESCRIPTION

DUR-A-SOLVE is a special combination of aromatic solvents, designed for use as an epoxy thinner. It is specifically formulated for use with DUR-A-GLAZE #4, DUR-A-GLAZE Novolac and, DUR-A-GARD Epoxy Coating. It is an exceptionally efficient solvent for this purpose. Flash point is approximately 85°F as per Closed Cup Test.

Generally, adding 3 - 9% of DUR-A-SOLVE is all that is needed to produce a desired viscosity. Adding DUR-A-SOLVE to a blended epoxy will extend the pot life and the curing time.

IMPORTANT: When DUR-A-SOLVE is used in a Primer Coat, wait 60 minutes or more before proceeding with the next application to permit the solvent to evaporate. Trapping solvent will prevent a proper cure at the bond line, and adhesion failure may result.

PACKAGING

DUR-A-SOLVE is available in 1- gallon cans, 5-gallon pails and 50-gallon drums.

All solvents may be harmful or fatal if swallowed. These products are flammable or combustible. DUR-A-SOLVE vapors are harmful. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame.
